1. Where do I apply for a Paediatric Network Position?

3. Which positions are the Paediatric Network Positions?

There are three types of Paediatric Training positions available in each of the Paediatric Training Networks. Each Network has the administrative responsibility for the advertising and recruitment process of one position. E.g.

1. Paediatric Resident

Position Number: 4699

Service: Sydney Children's Hospitals Network

Facility: Sydney Children's Hospital (this position is advertised by this AHS on behalf of the three paediatric networks)

2. Basic Paediatric Trainee

Position Number: 4680

Service: Sydney Children's Hospitals Network

Facility: The Children's Hospital at Westmead (this position is advertised by this AHS on behalf of the three paediatric networks)

3. Advanced Paediatric Trainee

Position Number: 4724

Service: Hunter New England Area Health Service

Facility: John Hunter Hospital (this position is advertised by this AHS on behalf of the three paediatric networks)

4. How do I find the above positions on the NSW Health JMO Jobs site?

A. CHW is managing the applications for the Basic Paediatric Trainees for all three networks:
This is listed with the position number 4680.

This can be located by selecting

- **Position Title:** "Basic Trainee"
- **Specialty:** "Paediatrics"
- **Network** "NSW Paediatrics Training Networks"
- And leaving all other fields blank
- When the search is returned, the position is the one with the position number (4680).

B. John Hunter Hospital is managing the applications for the Advanced Paediatric Trainees for all three networks: This is listed with the position number 4724.

This can be located by selecting

- **Position Title:** "Advanced Trainee"
- **Specialty:** "Paediatrics"
- **Network** "NSW Paediatrics Training Networks"
- And leaving all other fields blank
- When the search is returned, the position is the one with the position number **(4724)**.

C. Sydney Children's Hospital is managing the applications for the Paediatric Residents for all three networks: This is the position number 4699.

This can be located by selecting

- Position Title: "Resident Medical Officer"
- **Specialty:** "Paediatrics"
- **Network** "NSW Paediatrics Training Networks"
- And leaving all other fields blank
- When the search is returned, the position is the one with the position number **(4699)**.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Applying to these positions, which are linked to these facilities, does NOT mean that you are only applying to work at that facility. You will be given the chance to preference your hospital choice if successful for an interview.
